Falcons give children and young people amazing opportunities to make friends, experience new things and have fun. Whilst engaging in varied activities, they will also have the chance to explore life with Jesus in a relevant and creative way.

Falcons are designed to suit those who face disadvantage in their daily lives and are otherwise unlikely to have a holiday. These holidays are heavily subsidised, so cost is not a barrier to any young person being able to attend.

Each holiday is run by a team of committed and enthusiastic volunteer leaders, making them ideal for children to come on their own, with a friend, or as part of a group.

Young people that come on a Falcon holiday will take home memories that last a lifetime.

WHAT DIFFERENCE CAN IT MAKE?

Falcon holidays are a time of fun, friendship and community and have a positive impact on the self-esteem of many of the children and young people that attend.¹

ARE FALCON HOLIDAYS JUST FOR CHRISTIANS?

Not at all! All young people, regardless of faith, are welcome to experience all of the fun and opportunities that a Falcon holiday has to offer.

WHO IS IN CHARGE?

The Leaders of each Falcon are accountable to the staff and trustees of CPAS. They put together a team of friendly, approachable, enthusiastic, caring and skilled people. All the team members are thoroughly checked through our safeguarding policy.

WHAT ABOUT COST?

The price of a Falcon holiday covers everything except the cost of getting there and back! We keep the price of each Falcon as low as possible, so that more people are able to attend. When you book, you will need to pay a £10 deposit.

WHAT IF I STILL CAN'T AFFORD IT?

If you find that you can't afford to pay for the Falcon holiday, then speak to the person who gave you this leaflet or phone the Falcons office on 0300 123 0780, to find out how we may be able to help.

WHAT IF I HAVE TO CANCEL?

If you find that you need to cancel a place before the final fees are paid, you will lose your £10 deposit.²

TERMS & CONDITIONS

This is a summary of our terms and conditions. Our full terms and conditions can be found on our website Falcons.org.uk

When we accept your booking, there will be an agreement between: CPAS (church Pastoral Aid Society) at CPAS, Sovereign Court One, Sir William Lyons Road, Coventry CV4 7EZ ("we" or "us"), and the Member ("you"), and the parent or guardian of the Member Signing the form for the benefit of the Member ("your parent or guardian"), as follows:

1 THESE TERMS

- 1.1 What these terms cover. These are the terms and conditions on which we supply our holiday services to you. Our full terms and conditions can be found on our website falcons.org.uk
- 1.2 Why you should read them. Please read these terms carefully before you submit your booking to us. These terms tell you who we are, how we will provide the holiday to you, how you and we may change or end the contract, what to do if there is a problem and other important information. If you think that there is a mistake in these terms or require any changes, please contact us to discuss.

2 INFORMATION ABOUT US AND HOW TO CONTACT US

- 2.1 Who we are. We are Church Pastoral Aid Society (CPAS) a company and charity registered in England and Wales. Our company registration number is 2673220 and our registered office is at CPAS, Sovereign Court One, Sir William Lyons Road, Coventry, CV4 7EZ. We are also a registered charity and our registered charity number is 1007820.
- 2.2 How to contact us. You can contact us by telephoning the Ventures and Falcons Office on 0300 123 0780 or by writing to us at ventures@cpas.org.uk.
- 2.3 How we may contact you. If we have to contact you we will do so by telephone or by writing to you at the email address or postal address you provided to us in your reservation.
- 3 OUR CONTRACT WITH YOU
- 3.1 How we will accept your reservation. Our acceptance of your reservation will take place when we send our written confirmation to you, at which point a contract will come into existence between you and us.
- 3.2 If we cannot accept your booking, If we are unable to accept your booking, we will inform you of this in writing and will not charge you for the holiday. This might be because there are no more places available on the holiday, because of unexpected demands placed upon our resources which we could not

reasonably plan for, because a payment for the holiday has failed, because we have identified an error in the price or description of the holiday or because we are unable to provide the holiday on the dates you have requested.

- 3.3 Your reference number. We will assign a reference number to you and tell you what it is when we accept your booking (e.g. BKG123456).
- Permission to use photographs. 4 CPAS Ventures and Falcons may take photographs or videos during the holiday for publicity purposes. These images may appear in our printed publications, promotional materials, advertising, on our website or on social media. You are required to indicate whether you give consent for this at the point of reservation. If you have any concerns about this, please contact the Leaders of your holiday, advertised on the website or in the brochure or contact the Ventures and Falcons Office. You can change your mind at any point by the same contact methods.
- 5 You can always end your contract with us. Your rights when you end the contract will depend on the type of holiday you have bought, whether there is anything wrong with it, how we are performing and when you decide to end the contract. A full list of reasons you may want to end the contract with us can be found on our website.
- How long do I have to change my 6 mind? You can cancel your place on the holiday at any time before the balance of the price is due and you will be entitled to receive a full refund less your deposit. Please note that if you cancel your holiday, we may have already incurred costs on your behalf and other customers may not be able to go on the holiday if the minimum number of people booked drops below the minimum required. A full list of cancellation charges can be found in our full terms and conditions which are available on our website.

7 HOW TO END THE CONTRACT WITH US

7.1 Tell us you want to end the contract. To end the contract with us, please let us know by either phone or email. Call the Ventures and Falcons Office on 0300 123 0780 (option 1) or email us at ventures@cpas.org.uk. Alternatively, you can email or call the individual responsible for bookings as advertised in our brochure or on our website. Please provide your name, home address, details of the holiday and, where available, your phone number and email address.

8 OUR RIGHTS TO END THE CONTRACT

- 8.1 We may end the contract if you break the terms of the contract. We may end the contract for a holiday at any time by writing to you if:
 - 8.1.1 you do not make any payment to us when it is due; or
 - 81.2 you do not, within a reasonable time of us asking for it, provide us with information that is necessary for us to provide the holiday, for example, for example, passport information and medical information.
- 9 IF THERE IS A PROBLEM WITH THE HOLIDAY
- 9.1 How to tell us about problems. If you have any questions or complaints about the holiday, please contact us within 14 days of the end of the holiday. You can telephone our Ventures and Falcons Office at 0300 123 0780 (option 1) or write to us at ventures@cpas.org.uk or at CPAS, Sovereign Court One, Sir William Lyons Road, Coventry, CV4 7EZ.

10 HOW WE MAY USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION


10.1 How we will use your personal information. We will use the personal information you provide to us:
